



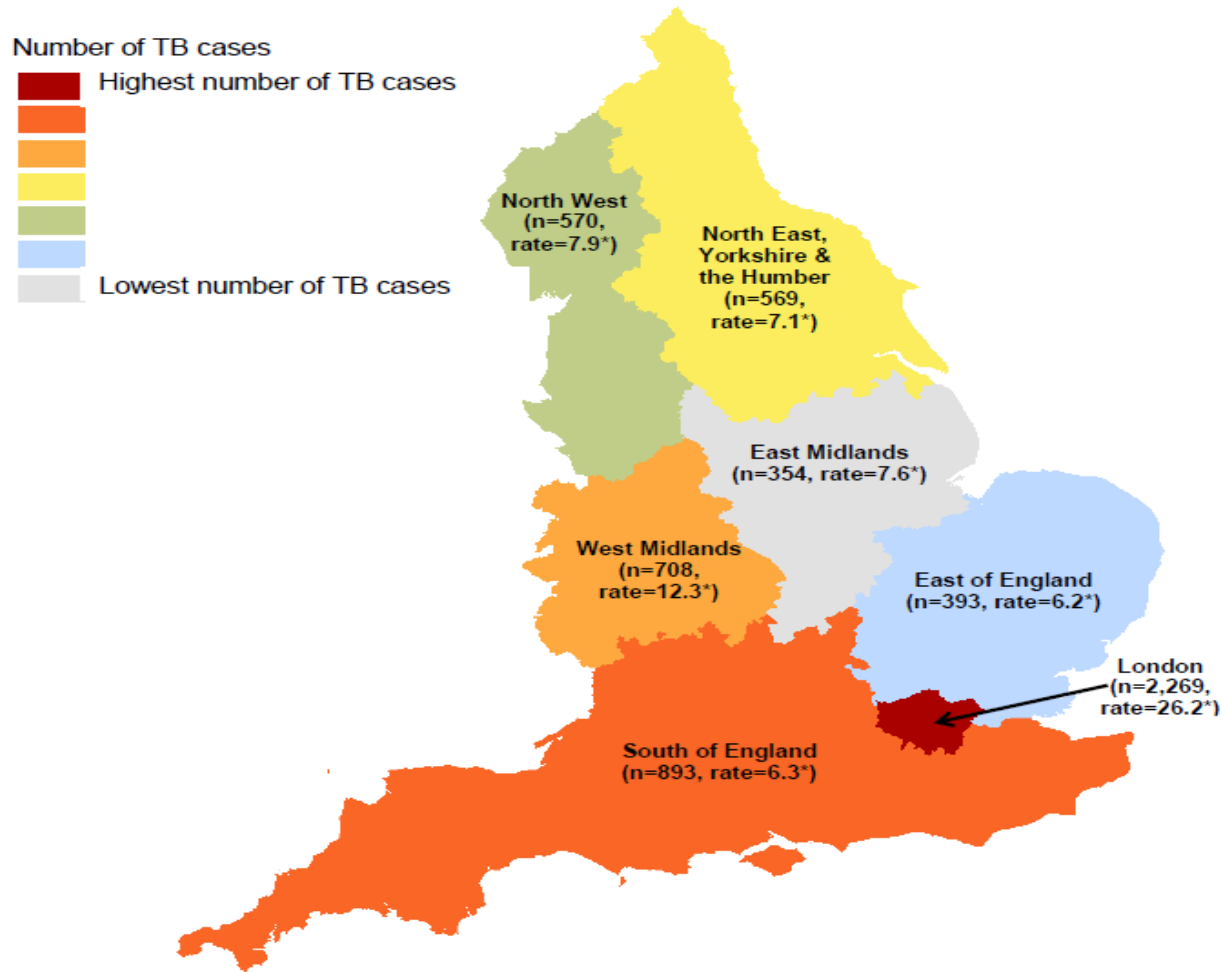

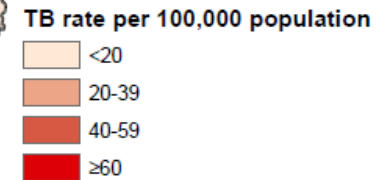
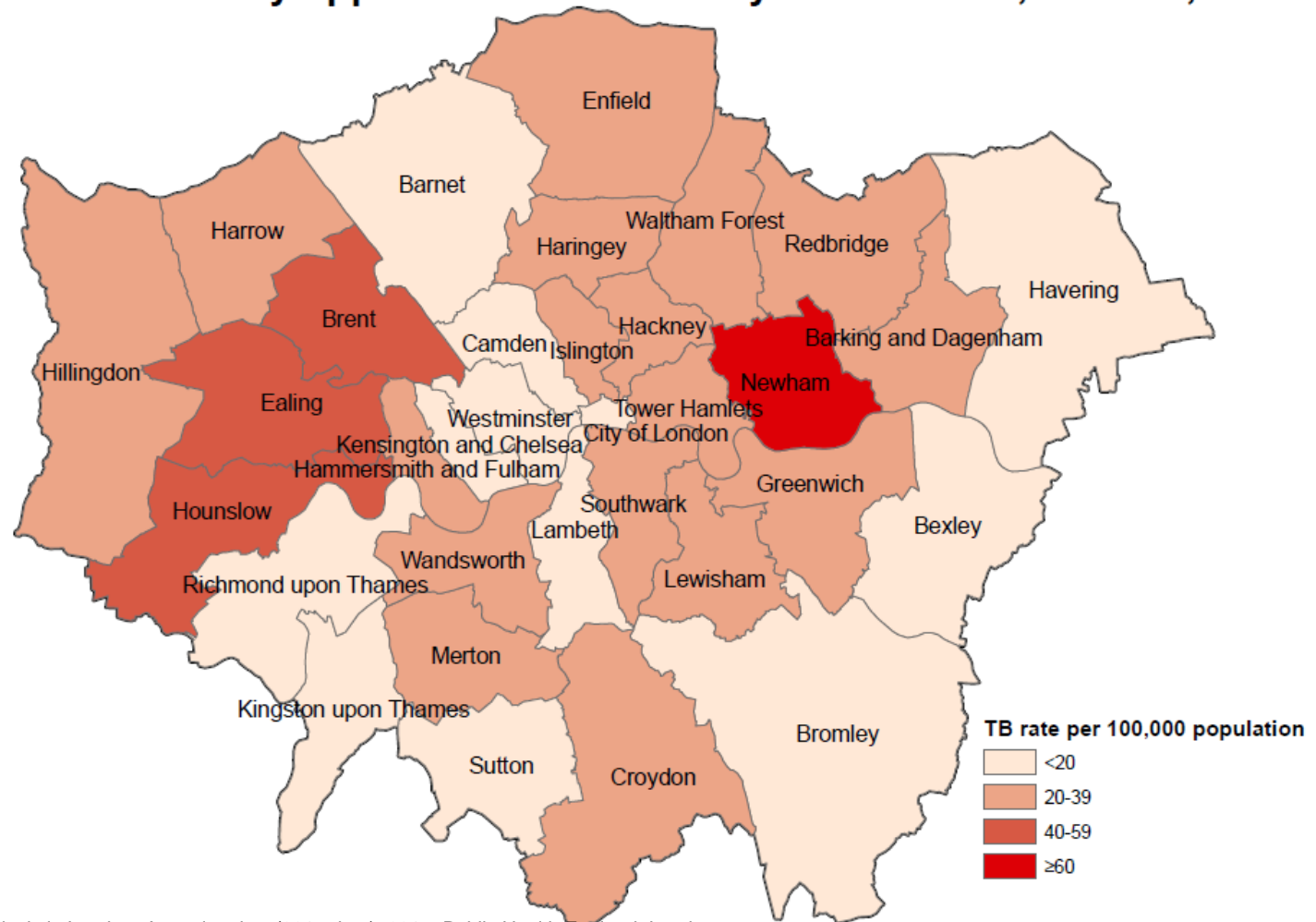

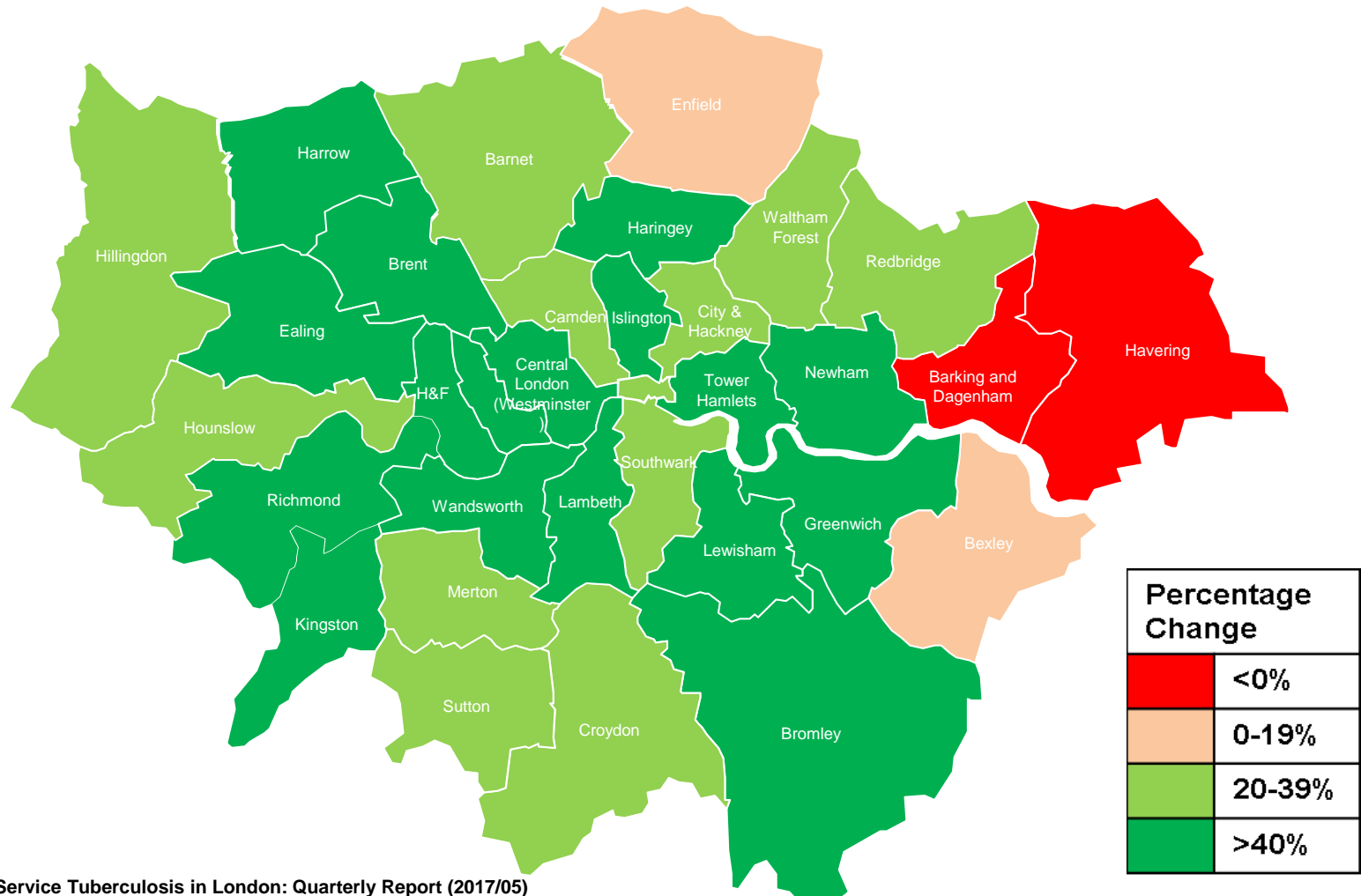

## TB case rate by upper tier local authority of residence, London, 2015





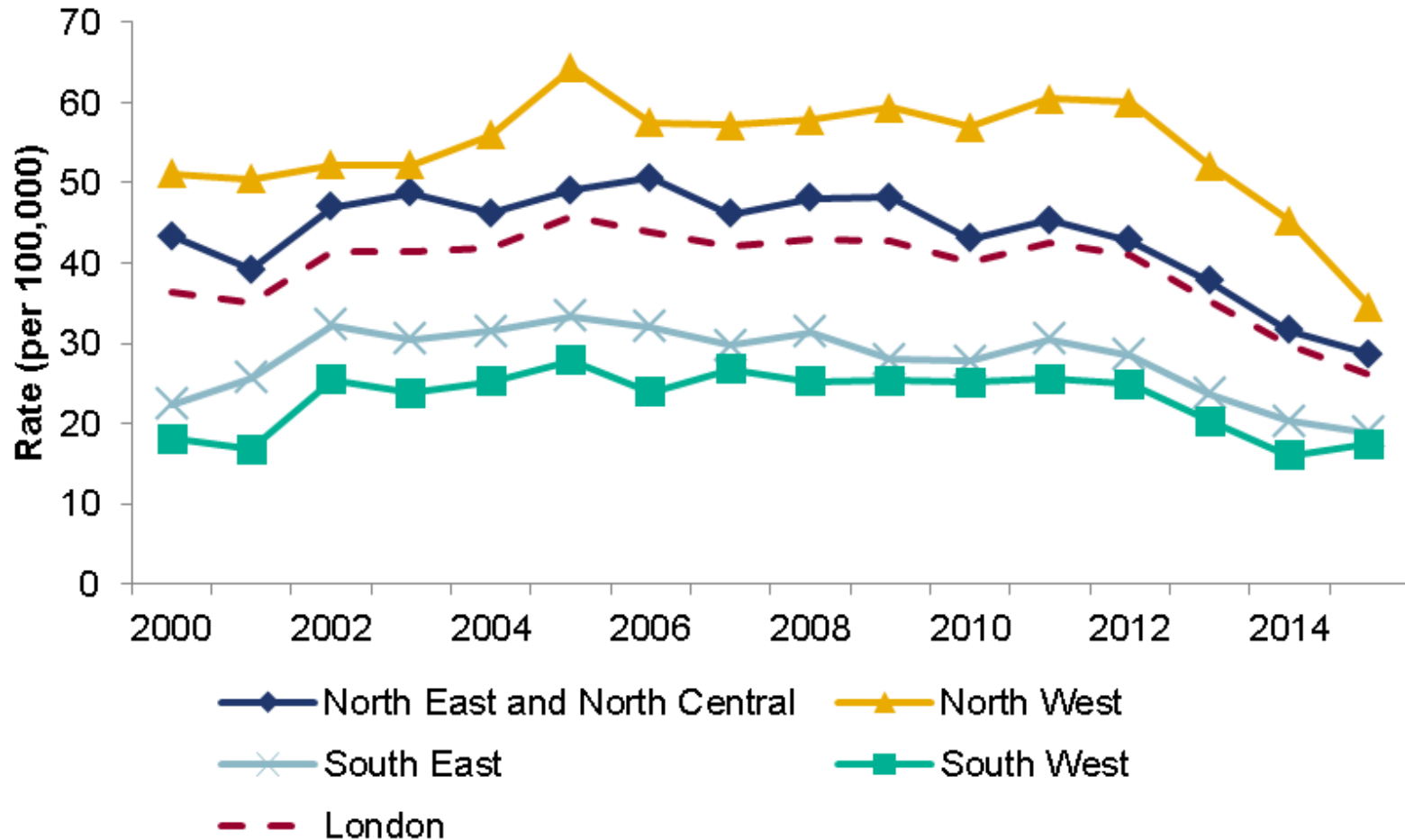
# Percentage decrease of TB incidence in London between 2011 and 2016\*

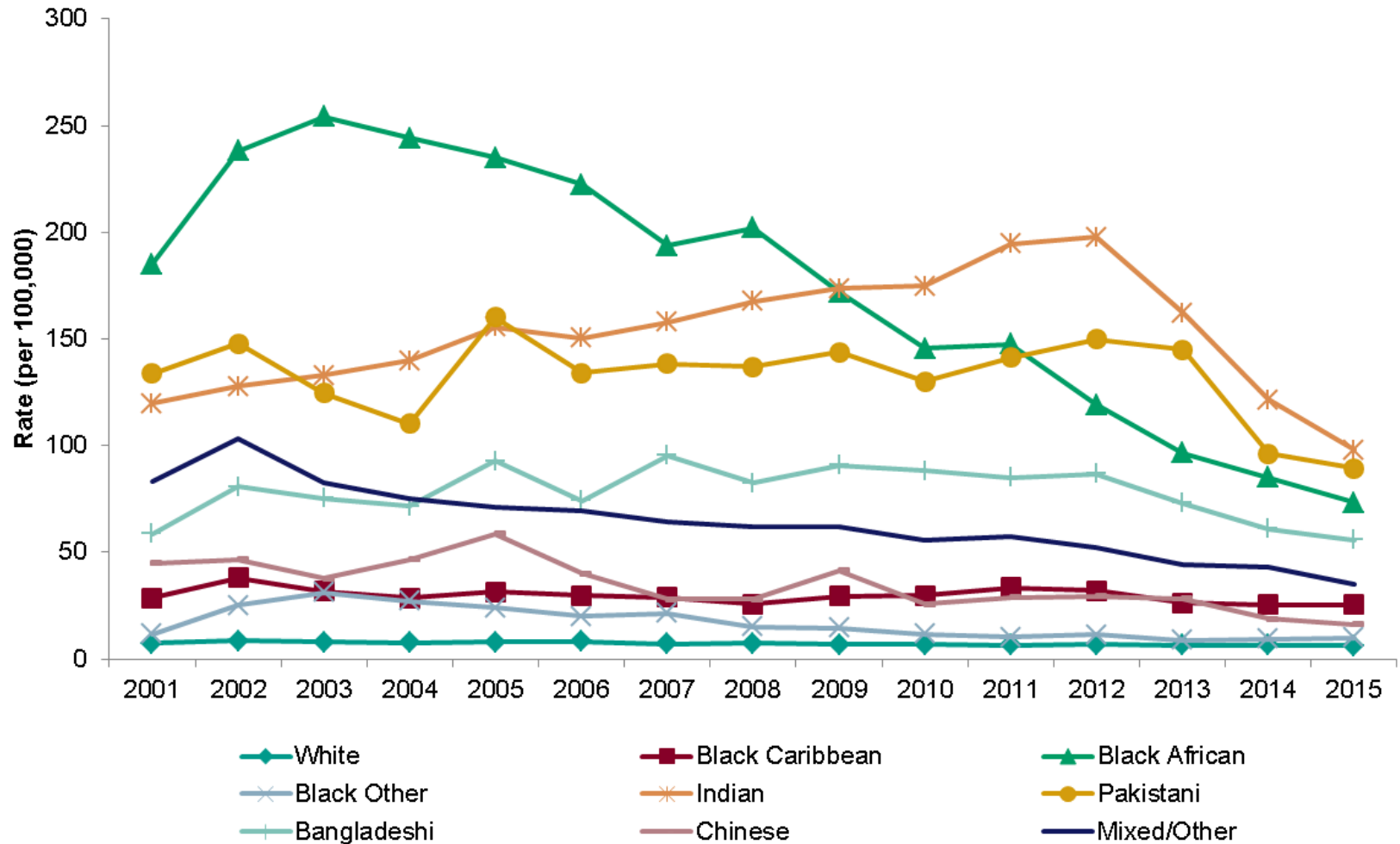


# TB incidence rates London 2000-2015





# TB incidence rates by ethnic groups London 2000-2015





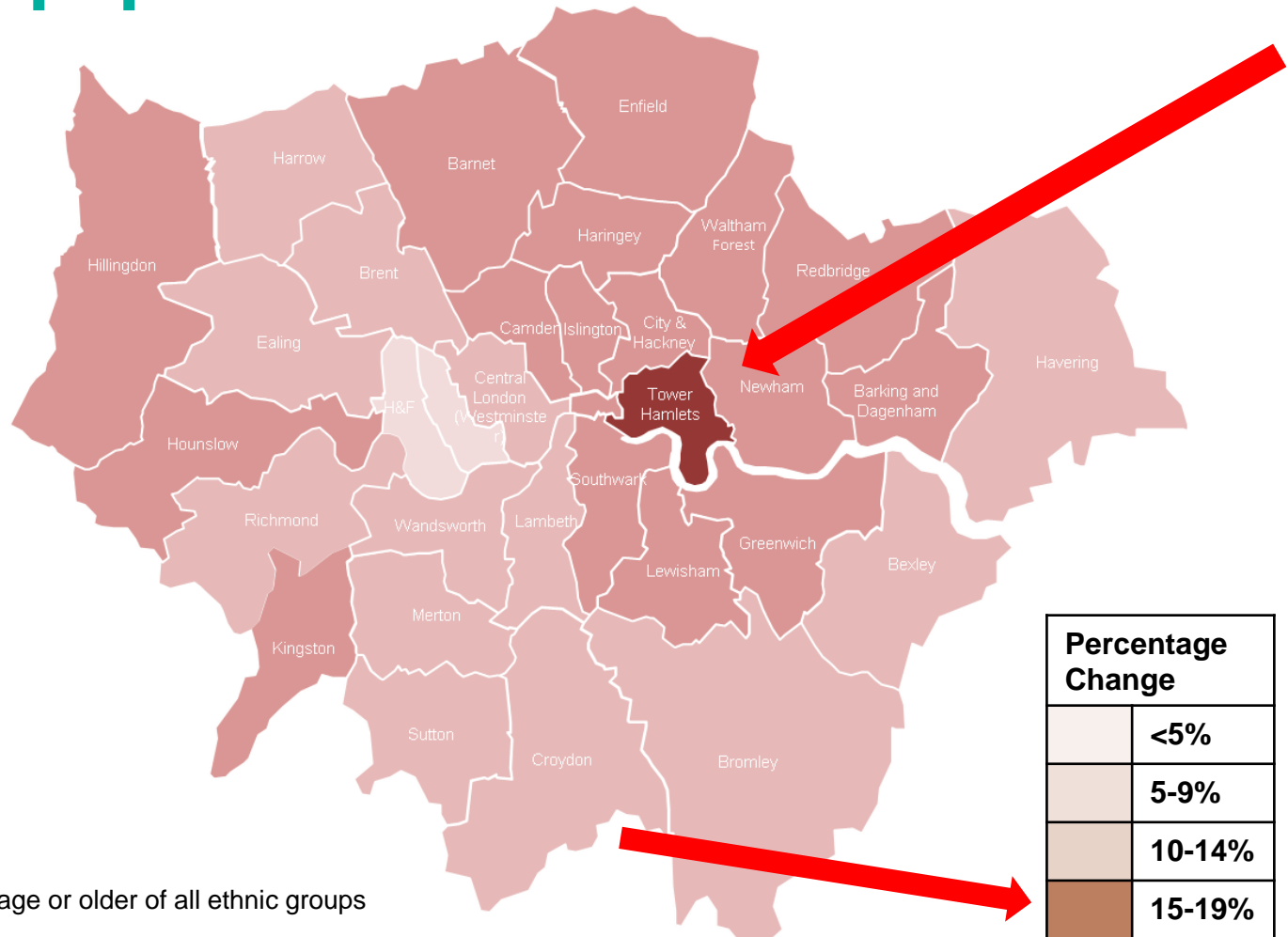
