High Diabetes Risk

At high diabetes risk = people identified as ever having:

- Impaired fasting glucose
- Impaired glucose tolerance
- Women who have had gestational diabetes but tested normal following delivery
- QDiabetes score $\geq 20\%$

High risk of diabetes mellitus No previous entry
