How did we improve?

We adapted searches provided by the CEG and created “lagging” searches which were imported into each practice's Emis Population Manager to identify any patient who had been screened but correctly read coded

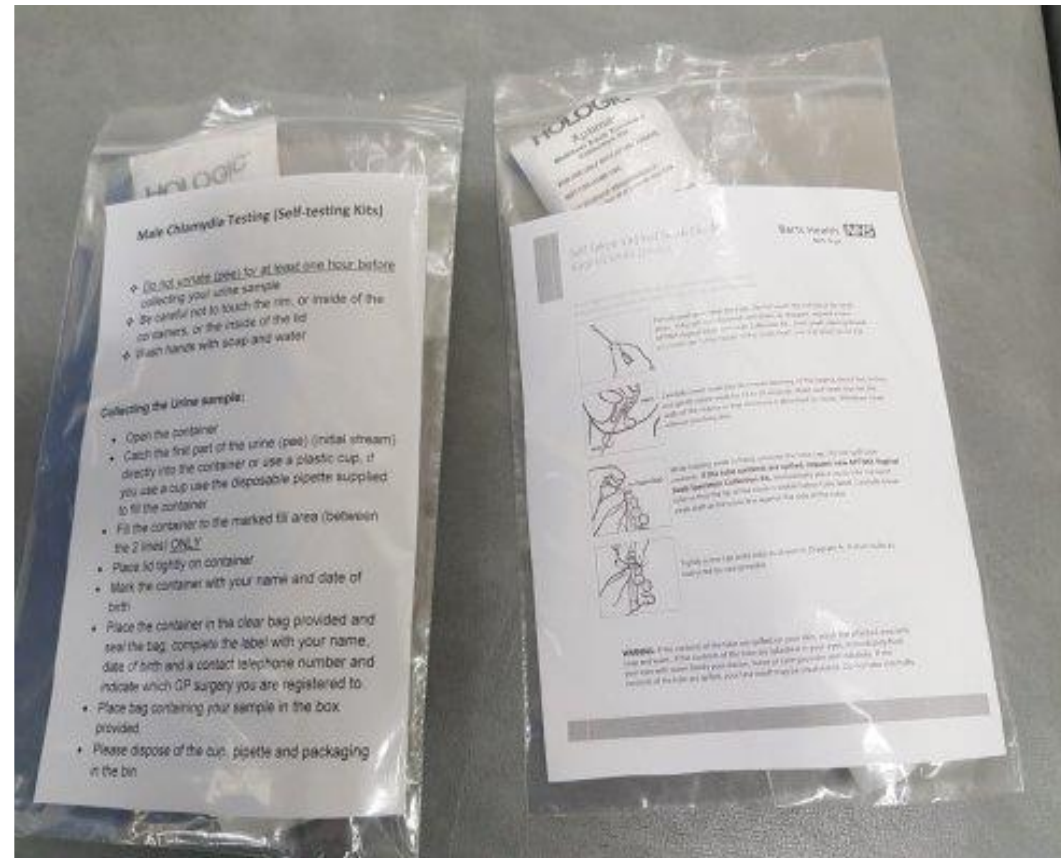

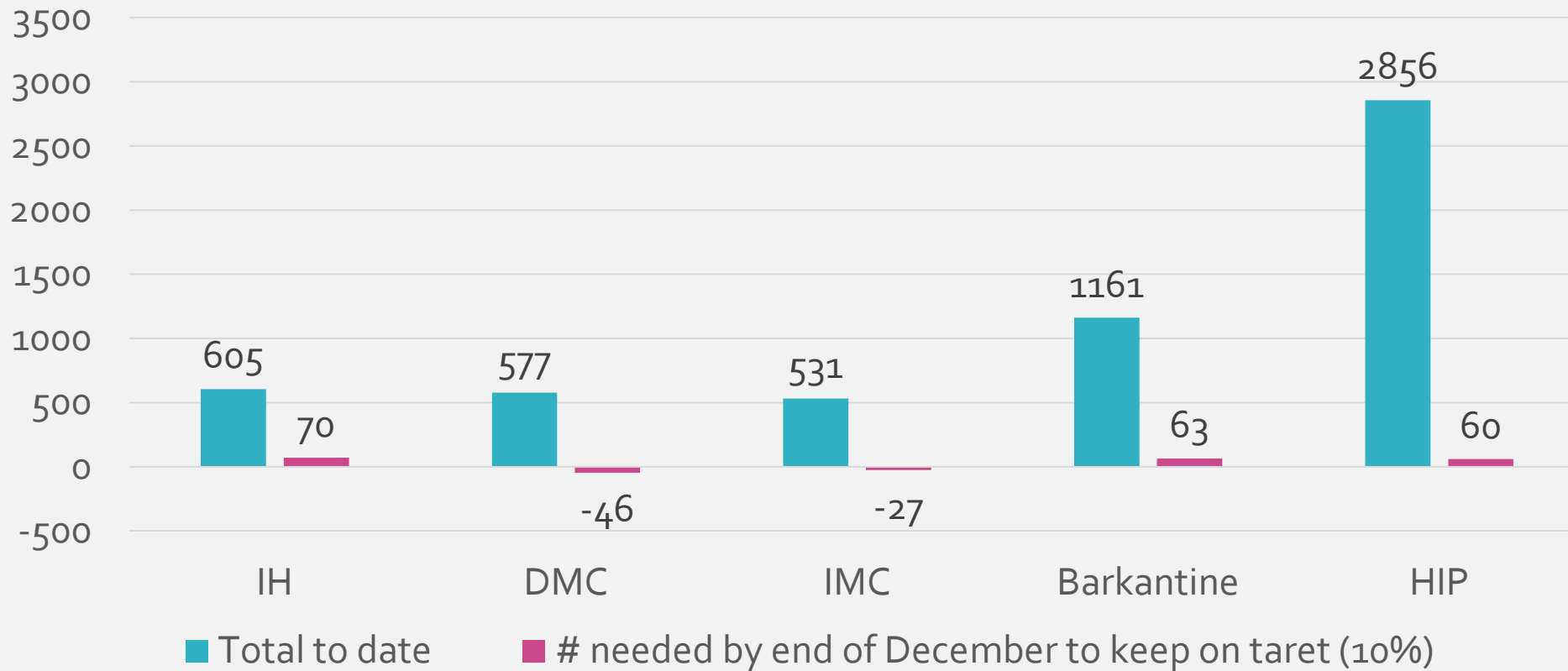
In addition we adapted searches provided by the CEG and created “lagging” searches which were imported into each practice's Emis Population Manager to identify patients with a positive result but had not been appropriately followed up (including Partner Notification)

How did we improve?

The network provided each practice with Self-Testing Kits that could be given out to patients at reception/available in clinical rooms to offer opportunistic screening.



How did we improve?



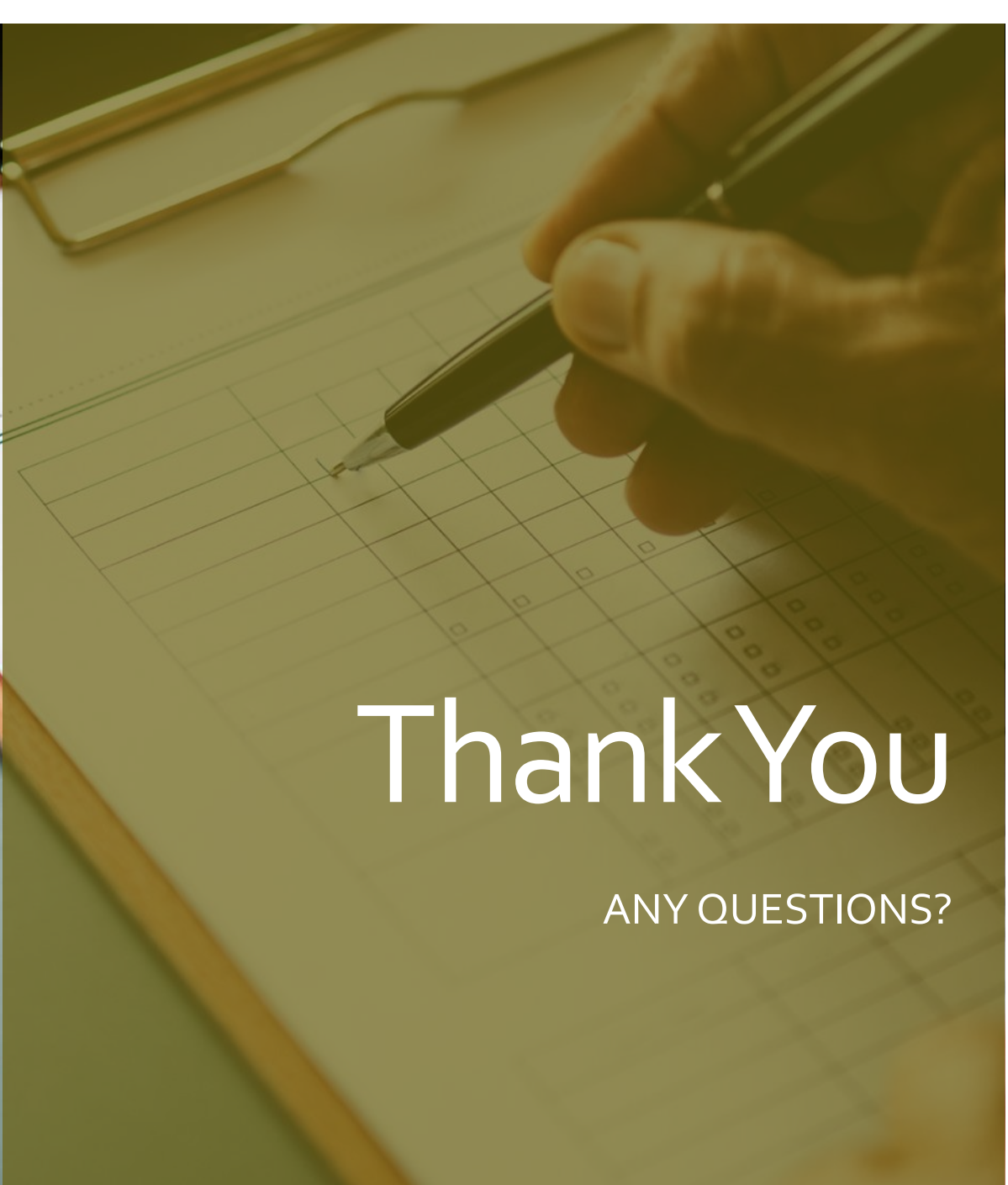
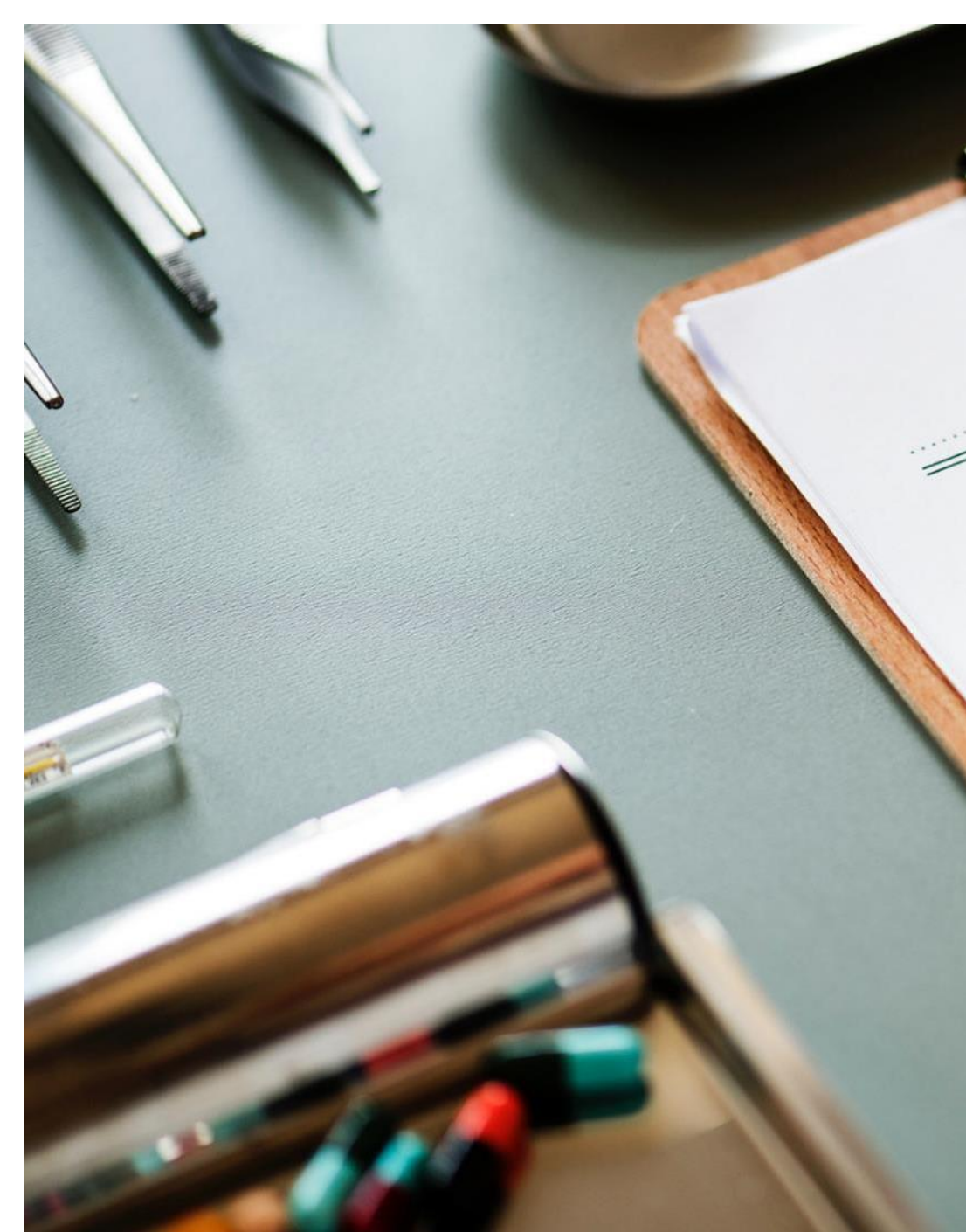
The network provides monthly feed-back to practices on progress



How did we improve?

Clinicians are encouraged to offer HIV/Syphilis/Hep B when requesting any blood tests, and Chlamydia/Gonorrhoea screening is routinely offered during appointments for cervical screening, contraception, and travel.
